Directions (For SatNav use RG27 0PX)

From M3 J4A

Head north on A327. At the roundabout take the first exit onto Minley Rd/A327 heading to Reading/Blackwater/A30/Yateley. Continue to follow A327 and go through one roundabout. At the next roundabout, take the first exit onto A30. Go through one roundabout, turn right at the next roundabout onto the A327. Turn left at Church into Church Farm (at Eversley Barn Antiques).

From M4 J11

Take the A33 towards Basingstoke, follow for 5 miles, at roundabout take the second exit and continue past Wellington Riding, take first left into B3011. At the roundabout take the second exit and continue on B3011. After approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile bear left onto B3272. At the end turn left onto A327 and do a U-turn at the roundabout. Church Farm is on the right after $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.

Rules and conditions of entry

- 1. All riders must wear hard hats/crash helmets to current PAS/BSEN standards, body protectors are recommended.
- 2. Children under the age of 12 must be escorted by an adult.
- 3. Horses and ponies must be at least 4 years old.
- 4. No horse or pony may be ridden round the course more than once.
- 5. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Riders must not deviate from the course.
- 7. Passing is allowed but only 3 attempts at any jump may be made, after which riders must move on.
- 8. Any rider found to be riding in a dangerous or reckless manner will be stopped and disqualified.
- 9. Failure to carry out instructions from a steward can lead to

- disqualification.
- 10. The decision of the Organizers on any matter shall be final.
- 11. The Organizing Committee, Land Owners and all persons involved with the ride disclaim all liability for any damage or injury to any person or property, howsoever caused, whether by negligence or otherwise. It is up to the participants and spectators to make their own insurance arrangements.

The Ride

The ride will start at 10.00 am with the last riders going at 1.30 pm. Starting times, to the nearest 1/2 hour, will be allocated. Riders will be asked to set off in pairs or small groups. Children under the age of 12 years MUST be accompanied by an adult. The course will close at 3.30 pm. A rosette will be awarded to every rider who completes the course.

The Course

The ride takes place over Forestry Commission and privately owned farmland. The course is approximately 12 miles in length with an early option to take a short cut to make it 8 miles. There are upwards of 60 jumps on the course all of which are optional and range in size from 18" to 3'3". Stewards will be present to inform riders about the choices. Every line of jumps and the one road crossing will be stewarded. The whole route will be clearly marked with yellow arrows. Official vehicles only have access to the forest and farmland.
